SAFETY FIRST

GENERAL RANGE RULES

1. **ALWAYS** Keep the Gun Pointed in a Safe Direction.
2. **ALWAYS** Keep Your Finger Off the Trigger Until Ready to Shoot.
3. **ALWAYS** Keep the Gun Unloaded Until Ready to Use.
4. Know Your Target and What is Beyond; Make Sure the Downrange Area is Unoccupied.
5. Be Sure the Gun is Safe to Operate.
6. Be Thoroughly Familiar With How the Gun Operates.
7. Use Only the Correct Ammunition for your Gun.
8. Eye and ear protection is required.
9. **DO NOT** handle firearms while someone is forward of the firing line.
10. **ALL SHOOTERS MUST SHOOT FROM THE SAME FIRING LINE** / Shooters **MUST** be positioned side by side and **MUST NOT** be staggered forward or aft of your position.
Shooting when person(s) is / are down-range from your position is NEVER ACCEPTABLE.
11. All firearms must have actions open if a person is down range or farmer is in immediate vicinity.
12. Unattended Guns must not be Accessible to Unauthorized Persons.
13. Be Aware That Certain Types of Guns and Many Shooting Activities Require Additional Safety Precautions.
14. Members Only. Guests permitted ONLY during scheduled club events or when accompanied by a current member and ONLY AFTER a guest pass or tandem pass has been purchased. NO EXCEPTIONS - VIOLATION OF THIS RULE WILL RESULT IN A BOARD REVIEW TO DETERMINE CONTINUATION OF MEMBERSHIP.
15. Range(s) may be closed during scheduled events.
16. Courtesy and sharing range etiquette expected when using ranges.
17. Paper targets only - attached to black target backers only. Bullets should NEVER hit the posts or the protective red strips at the top of the target backer.
18. **NO** alcoholic beverages allowed.
19. Never Use Alcohol or Drugs Before or While Shooting.
20. **NO** littering – remove targets and dispose of all trash.
21. **NO** vehicles allowed on range.
22. **NO** shotguns to be used on target backers, except slugs.
23. Any violation of the rules can result in expulsion.
24. **NO** weapons fired in full auto mode or with binary triggers. Immediate expulsion.
25. Display membership card in **FULL VIEW** when shooting. A full view card allows policing for non-members.
26. Firing at any target support is cause for expulsion.
27. **Be aware of a working farm area behind the safety berms. Stop all shooting until farmer is clear.**

SAFETY FIRST

SUPPLEMENTAL 100 YARD RIFLE RANGE RULES

- Limit rifle fire to three (3) round strings.
- **NO** automatic / rapid fire.
- **ALL** shooting must take place from the bench.
- Paper Targets Only - **No other targets permitted**.

Be aware of a working farm area behind the safety berm. Stop all shooting until farmer is clear.

SUPPLEMENTAL 50 YARD RIFLE / PISTOL RANGE RULES

- Foot access only from Rifle Range parking area – vehicles not permitted account wet grounds.
- Limit rifle fire to three (3) round strings and handguns to six (6) round strings.
- **NO** automatic / rapid fire.
- Paper Targets Only; **No other targets permitted**.
- Pistols, rifles and shotguns with slugs permitted.

Be aware of a working farm area behind the safety berm. Stop all shooting until farmer is clear.

SUPPLEMENTAL 25 YARD and 15 YARD PISTOL RANGE RULES

- Pistols and rimfire and muzzle loader rifles ONLY. **NO CENTERFIRE RIFLES OR BRACED PISTOLS**.
- Handguns, rimfire rifles & muzzleloaders ONLY permitted – **NO CENTERFIRE RIFLES** (for example AR).
- **NO** shotshells.
- 2nd Saturday – Spring and Summer – Bullseye match – open to all – 9:00 – 12:00.
- 25 yard range closed for Bullseye matches; 15 yard range open.
- Pistol ranges open during shotgun matches and practices.

SUPPLEMENTAL SHOTGUN PATTERNING BOARD RANGE RULES

- Shotguns only; shotshells only.
- **NO** slugs, pistols or any other firearms permitted.
- Please supply your patterning cardboard.

SUPPLEMENTAL SHOTGUN / TRAP SHOOTING RANGE RULES

Hand throwing is allowed but please keep area clean.
